1. Regulation

Deadline for samples' **submission** is **May 12th, 2016**

2. Registration process (online or by e-mail)

- Online registration:

Please log on http://www.iwcb.ro/registration/index_eng.html and follow all steps.

Do not forget to attach (format .doc, pdf., or .jpg):

- Analysis Certificate of the sample
- A copy of wine label and back label for every sample

- E-mail registration:

If you cannot register your samples online, please download registration forms (Participant Registration Form and Product Registration Form) from <http://www.iwcb.ro/eng/samples-registration>, fill the forms and sign them both.

These two submission forms, together with the Analysis Certificate of each sample and a copy of both the label and back label of that particular sample, have to be scanned and sent by email to: daniela.paduraru@iwcb.ro

3. Registration confirmation

After sending the above mentioned documents, you will receive a confirmation by email on the email address you provided in the Participant Registration Form.

VERY IMPORTANT ! You should proceed with samples' delivery only after receiving the confirmation email .

4. Samples delivery

ONLY after receiving the confirmation email, you should delivery a full 6 bottles box, clearly labeled with the name of the sample to the address below :

All samples should be delivered with labels designated for the commercial presentation of the products, complying with the rules and regulations from the originating country. In case the product was bottled and labeled especially for the contest, you should send documents explaining the reason.

Samples will be sent with all submission documents, as follows :

- Participant Registration Form
- Product Registration Form
- Analysis Certificate of each sample
- A copy of a product label and back label for each sample

The shipping document attached to the consignment should bear the name of Sender and the sentence SAMPLES FOR CONTEST, NO COMMERCIAL VALUE

In case of samples' delivery by air, you should clearly specify on the shipping document DDP delivery condition.

WARNING !

Every submitted sample has to be a part from a bottled commercial batch of at least 1000 litres. Just in particular situations, such as old collection wines, ice wines, botrytized wines - samples can be submitted for bottled commercial batches of at least 100 litres.

Samples must be accompanied by an analysis certificate drawn up by an accredited laboratory of a competent laboratory in conformity with the laws of the country or certified by an oenologist in charge of the wine cellar and with, at least, the hereinafter specifications:

For still wines, sparkling wines and pearl wines :

- Alcoholic strength by volume at 20°C % vol.
- Sugar (glucose + fructose) g/l
- Total acidity g/l
- Volatile acidity g/l
- Sulphur dioxide (SO₂) total mg/l
- Sulphur dioxide (SO₂) free mg/l
- Concerning sparkling and pearl wine:

For spiritous beverages of vitivinicultural origin :

- Alcoholic strength by volume at 20°C % vol.
